2. 1.2 Explain behavioral and environmental factors that contribute to major chronic diseases and the methods for reducing problems associated with common conditions (asthma, allergies, diabetes, and epilepsy)
3. 1.3 Interpret personal health appraisal data to assess personal risks for preventable disease
4. 2.1 Critique medical information resources in terms of reliability, unreliability, accuracy, and significance
5. 2.2 Judge the effects of popular fads on health (tattooing, piercing, artificial fingernails)
6. 3.1 Outline the potential health consequences of global environmental problems
7. 3.2 Explain the impact of personal behaviors on the environment, both positively and negatively
